Description of Activity	<p>The process of campus placements involves several steps which the respective placement representatives will guide the students through. Companies visit the college campus to select candidates through a process that may include aptitude tests, interviews, and group discussions.</p> <p>To maximize the chances of getting selected, having a well-crafted resume, preparing for aptitude tests, and being well-groomed and knowledgeable during interviews is essential. Group discussions require good general knowledge, listening, and speaking skills. Meeting the college's criteria and avoiding backlogs is essential.</p> <p>Once a placement is confirmed, one cannot reject their internship offer. During placement, one should communicate, keep their profile ready, be punctual and attentive, actively attend pre-placement talks, and commit to staying in the organization for at least a year, based on company guidelines. Companies typically start visiting campuses in August 2023. Students should remember that there may be limits on the number of attempts allowed, and maintaining a minimum of 85% attendance is necessary.</p>

Students recognized that relying too heavily on AI tools and plagiarizing content could handicap their originality and undermine academic integrity.</p> <p>The speaker then transitioned to professionalism. 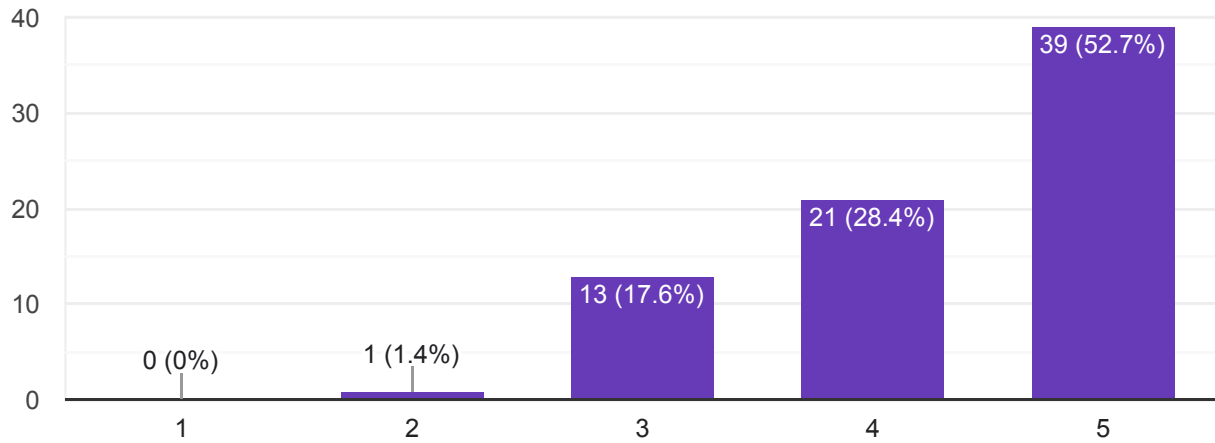

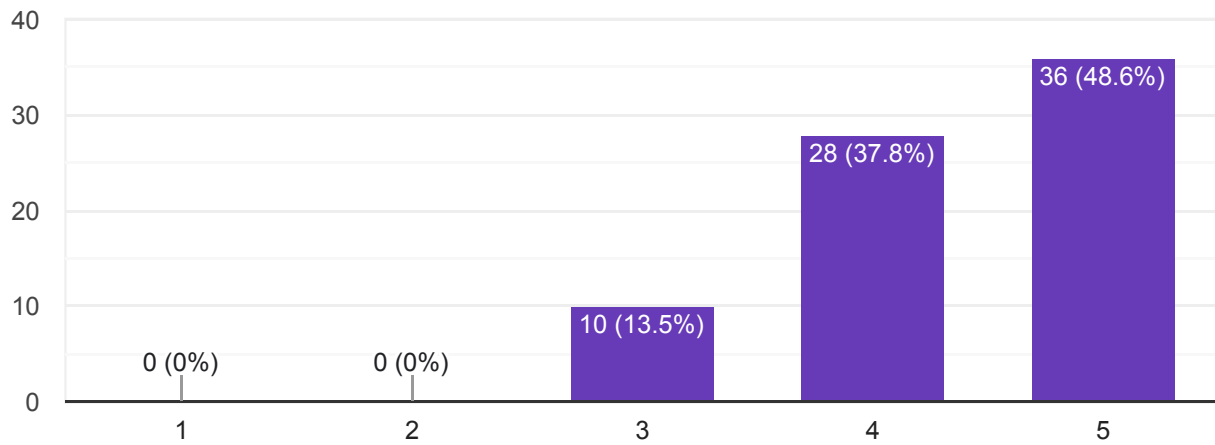

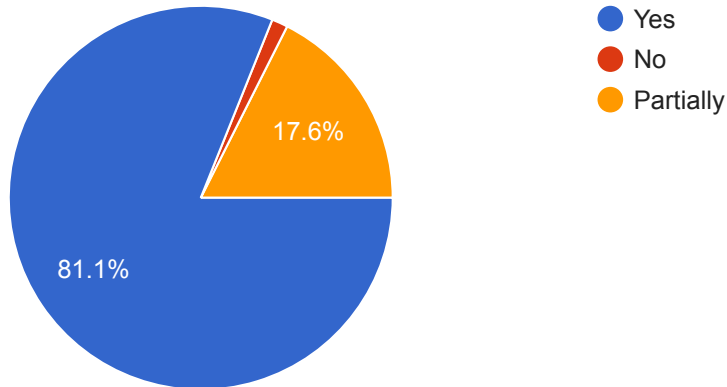

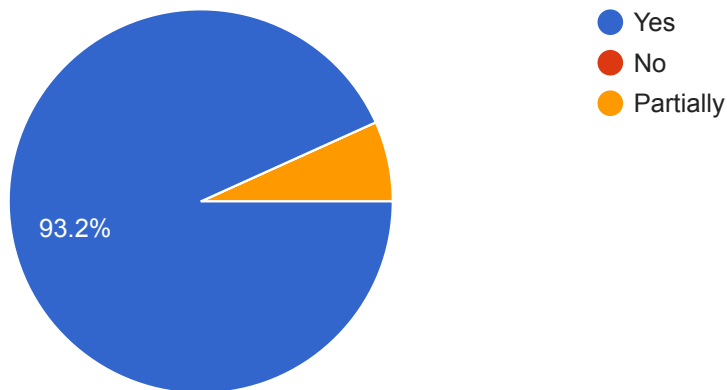

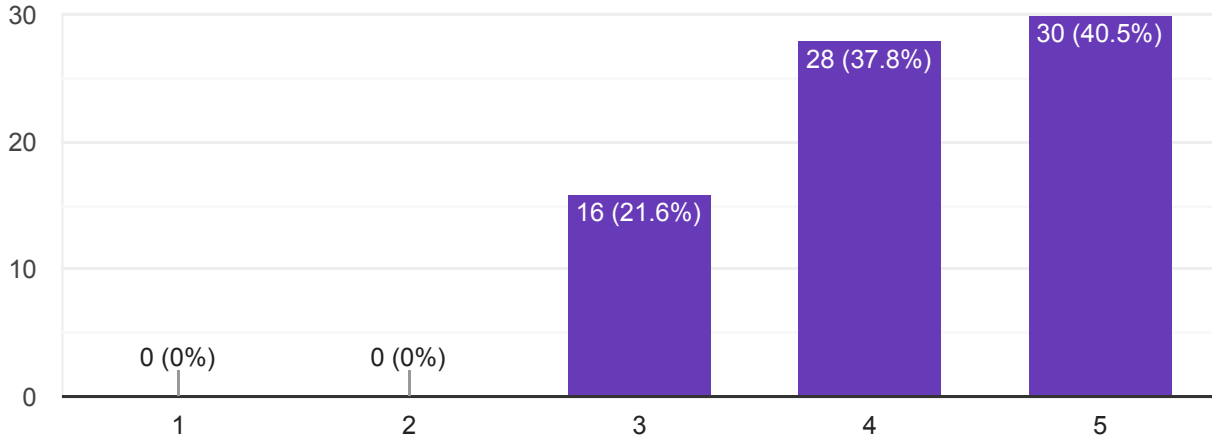

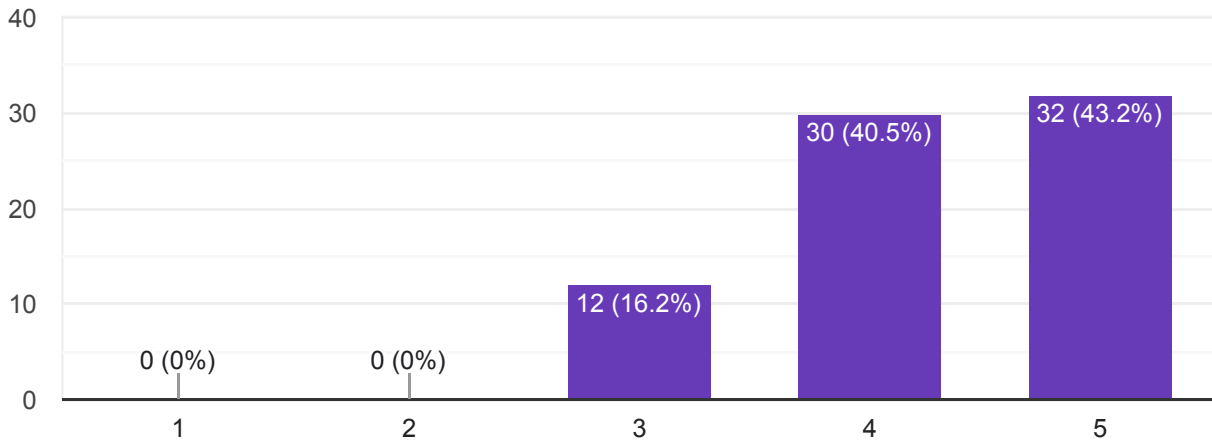
