*TRANSFER OF STUDENTS TO FOREIGN UNIVERSITY IN 2018*

BBA (Finance & International Business) Programme is an innovative concept in education, which provides an opportunity and access to students for studies abroad. They complete the first two years of foreign degree programme at CHRIST (Deemed to be University) in Bangalore, India. Then, proceed to complete the remaining years of studies at the affiliated foreign university.

**Objectives of International Programme BBA (Finance & International Business)**

- To provide quality education at reasonable cost
- To provide educational experience through international exposure
- To qualify students for world competition in the global employment market
- To increase student capacity to lead productive and responsible lives and also bring about open minded, tolerant and humanistic approach towards each other on the campuses and in the world community

**Degree Offered**

The degree is awarded by the foreign university on completion of the programme.

**Visa**

The responsibility of obtaining the visa rests with the student. CHRIST (Deemed to be University) will provide assistance in procurement of visa. The students must be ready to furnish proof that necessary finance is available for the expenses at the foreign university.

**Options Available for Transfer to Foreign Universities**

After completion of two years in CHRIST (Deemed to be University), students can transfer their credits to partner foreign university for completion of the programme. In the foreign university the students may spend either 1 or 1.5. (1 to 1.5 years)

BBA (Finance & International Business) students can transfer to any of the following eight partner universities of their choice. Students have 8 options:

(2 Years in CU + 1 Year in IESEG)

**Courses Offered**

**Bachelor Degree in Business Administration – BBA (2 + 1):** 3 years (6 Semesters) degree programme of which two years will be at CHRIST (Deemed to be University) and the remaining one year at IESEG School of Management.

**Master of Science Programme**

**MSc:** 2 years (4 semesters) degree programme.

The MSc degree programme is open to students having completed IESEG BBA and a direct entry is given in the MSc degree programme. Two semesters are dedicated to learning Management in classroom at IESEG School of Management. Students are also required to do a one-semester internship as a manager in France or abroad. Finally, all participants are required to complete a Master's thesis or consulting project in France or abroad (1 semester). Students can enroll without work experience.

**MBA-**Students will require work experience (minimum 2-3 years)

**Eligibility for Transfer to IESEG School of Management**

You can transfer to IESEG School of Management by completing 4 semesters at CHRIST (Deemed to be University) with a minimum grade point average of 2.0(70%) out of 4(100%).

**Tuition Fees and Accommodation Charges**

BBA Course: US \$ 11000 +US \$ 10500 approx (for 1 year)

MSc Course: US \$ 22000 +US \$ 21000 approx (for 2 years)

**Work while Study:** Foreign students are allowed to work 20 hrs per week once they have their resident permit.

**Work after BBA Study:** Students need sponsorship from the company to get work permit.

**Work after MSc Study:** Students will have a six month extension of visa after their MSc study to look for a job. Students need sponsorship from the company.

## **Option 2: SHEFFIELD HALLAM UNIVERSITY, UK**

(2 Years in CU + 1Year in SHU)

### **Since 2005**

Sheffield Hallam University is top ranked Modern University in North of England. It is the 3<sup>rd</sup> largest University in the UK. It has 35,000 students on campus out of which around 4000 are International students from 120 countries. The University is one of the UK's largest providers of courses involving work placements.

The University has Four Faculties offering around 700 programmes including Undergraduate, Postgraduate and some PhD options. More than 50,000 students live in Sheffield. It's green, lively, independent, safe, inexpensive and creative. It is the best place in the UK to be a student.

Sheffield was the UK's first National City of Sport, and the city regularly hosts major sporting events in venues including world-class swimming and diving pools, Motorpoint Arena and two major football stadiums (Sheffield United Football Club and Sheffield Wednesday Football Club). **Duration:** 1 year (1<sup>st</sup> week of September 2017 to June 30, 2018)

### **Eligibility for Transfer to Sheffield Hallam University**

You can transfer to Sheffield Hallam University by successfully passing/completing 4 semesters at CHRIST (Deemed to be University) with a minimum grade point average of 1.0(60%) out of 4 (100%). If applicant has scored 70% in English in Class 12<sup>th</sup> then IELTS can be waived off. If not scored 70% in English in Class 12<sup>th</sup> then IELTS has to be taken with an overall score of 6.0 with 5.5 in each skills or TOEFL equivalent.

### **Work while study:**

Students can work for 20 hours per week on or off campus while studying.

### **Master Programme (1 Year)—optional**

Students can enroll without work experience. On completion of the Bachelor's programme, students can progress into the following Master's programmes at Sheffield Hallam University. As a graduate of Sheffield Hallam University students will be entitled to a discount of 20% (upon achieving 60% or above on the bachelors course) or 10% (upon achieving 50% or above on the bachelor course).

Successful completion of two years BBA (Finance & International Business) program with overall aggregate of 75%, grade point average of 2.5 (first four semesters) and pass in all examined modules. Students will also need to achieve a TOEFL exam score of 79 (internet -based) 550 (paper- based) or 213 (computer –based).SAT not required

#### **OPT (Optional Practical Training)**

Students can apply for OPT after graduating from BWU. OPT allows the student to work for one year in the United States. During OPT students live off campus and earn a salary. The department of Career Services can assist students in finding jobs for OPT.

#### **MBA Program:**

Students completing their Undergraduate program at BWU, may continue on to the International MBA program. Work experience not required.

**Work while Study:** Foreign students are allowed to work on campus. However, students need to apply for the open positions and the selection is limited to available jobs on campus. Also, working more than 10 hours per week is discouraged.

(2 Years in CU + 1.5 Years in GU)

#### **Eligibility for Transfer to Griffith University**

You can transfer to Griffith University by successfully passing/completing 4 semesters at CHRIST (Deemed to be University) with grade point average of 1.0 (60%) out of 4.0. IELTS is the University's English requirement for entry into undergraduate program. Overall score of 6.5 with no subscore less than 6.0 is to be achieved.

#### **Tuition Fees (for 1.5 years)**

#### **Living expenses (for 1.5 years)**

US \$21000 approx

#### **Work while Study:**

Students can work for 40 hours per fortnight on or off campus while studying (Minimum wages Act A\$ 15 per hour). This pocket money can cover partial living expense.

**Post Study Work Visa:** To be eligible for the Post-study Work visa, students must have completed their studies in Australia while on student visa for Minimum 2.0 years (either take additional around 4 subjects i.e one extra semester for completion of undergraduate program or can enroll for Masters Program). Graduates who have completed a Bachelor Degree or Masters by course work degree in Australia will be eligible to apply for a post study work visa for 2.0 years. ### **Eligibility for Transfer to WMU**

A successful completion of two years study at CHRIST (Deemed to be University), Bachelor of Business Administration (Finance & International Business) programme with a minimum Grade Point Average of 2.5 ( 75%) + TOEFL + SAT. The University will provide the Form I-20 from WMU and will make it available to the students for visa purposes.

### **Work While Study**

Students can work for 20 hours per week on campus while studying. This pocket money can cover partial living expense.

### **Tuition Fees & Living expenses (for 1.5 years)**

US \$ 50000 +US \$ 18000 approx

Note:

1. Students need to take summer classes to complete the course in around 1 ½ years
2. Students can recover part of the living expense by working on campus.

### **OPT (Optional Practical Training)**

Students can work for one year in the company after completion of BBA. The student can get regular salary.

### **Masters Program**

MBA-Work experience not required. The program is conducted in the evening. The course can be completed in 2-3 years while working.
