

## Master of Arts in Educational Psychology

The MA (Educational Psychology) programme is a two year postgraduate degree which will be based on a scientist practitioner model of training.

The programme will emphasize

1. Intellectual engagement in the foundations, methods, and application of psychological principles as applied to educational psychology practice and related fields.
2. Pursuit of research-based understanding and critical appraisal of theories and concepts underlying the foundations and practices of psychology and education and how these intersect with the field of educational psychology.
3. Development and dissemination of educational psychology related information, knowledge, skills, policies, and practices for the benefit of children, families, schools, and society.

The outcomes of the programme will cover the following domains:

1. Professional dispositions (Including graduate attributes through reflections, engagement in community service, service learning, extra curriculums and so on)
2. Academic Knowledge (Through Classroom based pedagogies)
3. Practitioner competencies (Through Practicum, Internships and research)
