- Open to all departments across all Bangalore campuses of Christ University (Pan-University participation).
- Each Stall can have a maximum of four members.
- Stalls must showcase original student ideas and creativity, not just the reselling of massmanufactured products. Examples include handmade crafts, upcycled fabric pouches, t-shirts printed with students original art, Books by students, mini canvas paintings, customized stickers, or live calligraphy services.
- Startups are also allowed to put up a stall.
- Food stalls are not permitted. (Including packaged food items)
