- ◆ Music must be submitted through pen drive in .mp3 format.
- ◆ Creative use of props is encouraged.

Get ready to sing your hearts out in Resonance – the ultimate Group Singing Showdown for Classes 9 to 12! Whether you hit high notes or bring the bass, this is your chance to shine, vibe with your crew and turn up the volume on talent, teamwork and fun. Let the harmonies clash and the rhythm roll because the stage is calling and it's your time to steal the show!

- ◆ A maximum of two teams per college/school may participate (minimum of 5 & maximum of 10 Members per team). Maximum of 4 Microphones shall be provided for vocalists.
- ◆ Each team will be allotted 5 minutes for performance and 2 minutes for setup. Timing will begin from the moment the first instrument is connected or the performance begins. Exceeding the time limit may lead to negative marking.
- ◆ The competition is open to different forms and styles of singing (Indian classical, Western classical, folk, contemporary, and other vocal styles). Performances may be in any language.
- ◆ Participants may perform either their own original composition or an existing song. (Extra credit will be given for creative musical arrangements, innovative interpretations and original compositions.) In the case of an original composition, please provide a hard copy of the lyrics to the judges.
- ◆ One drum set will be provided by the organizers. Participants must bring the other instruments if required.

- ◆ Karaoke or pre-recorded tracks are not allowed. All performances must be accompanied by live music or acappella vocals.
- ◆ Vulgar, obscene, offensive, or disrespectful language, gestures, or content will not be permitted. Growling vocals are not permitted. This will result in immediate disqualification.
- ◆ Teams must report 30 minutes before the start of the event to pick their performance slot.
- ◆ All participants must carry a valid student ID card. (Participants without IDs will not be allowed to perform).
- ◆ The judges' decision is final and binding on all matters related to performance and scoring.

- ◆ Participants must immediately shift to the opposite stance and continue their argument.
- ◆ Judging will be based on clarity, logic, confidence, adaptability, and presentation.

- ◆ Boys' teams are eligible to participate.
- ◆ All team members must wear jerseys of the same color throughout the match. Teams without matching jerseys may not be permitted to participate.
- ◆ Matches will be played in a knockout format. In the event of a draw, the winner will be decided through a penalty shootout.
- ◆ Each team shall have 11 players on the field, including a goalkeeper. Teams may have up to 9 substitutes.
- ◆ Each match consists of two halves of 30 minutes each, with a 5-minute halftime break.
- ◆ All players must wear football studs and shin guards.
- ◆ Metal-studded shoes are strictly prohibited.
- ◆ All game-play rules, including fouls and violations, follow FIFA regulations.
- ◆ The referee's decision is final.

Clash of Titans

Tug of War

Participation in this event is open to both boys' and girls' teams.

Tug of War is a test of strength, coordination, strategy, and team spirit. Two teams pull opposite ends of a rope, aiming to bring the central mark across the designated line.

- ◆ Each team shall consist of eight participants.
- ◆ The rope used should be of a circumference of approximately 11 cm and should be marked in the middle with a centre line as well as two marks that should be placed 4 m from the centre line.
- ◆ At the start of the pull, the centre line of the rope should be immediately above the line marked on the ground.
- ◆ Both teams pull the rope, the winner will be the team that pulls the mark on the rope closest to their opponents over the centre line.
- ◆ Matches will be conducted in a best-of-three pulls format.

Sports Rules and Regulations

- ◆ The tournament is exclusively for students from PU colleges and those studying in Classes 9 to 12.
- ◆ Teams must provide their valid ID cards; failure to do so will result in disqualification from the event.
- ◆ Prize money will be awarded only if the minimum required number of teams/participants register for the event; otherwise, the organizers reserve the right to modify the prize structure or cancel the event.
- ◆ The matches will be played on a knockout basis.
- ◆ All matches will be held on the CHRIST Kengeri Campus.
- ◆ The last date for submission of the registration form is on or before 15.07.2026.
- ◆ No change of players shall be permitted during the tournament once the names in the entry form have been submitted.
- ◆ All team players are required to wear proper team attire; failure to do so will result in disqualification from the game.
- ◆ Teams should report to the venue 30 minutes before the scheduled time.
- ◆ The referee's decision shall be final and binding as far as the rules are concerned. Any misconduct by team members will lead to disqualification from the tournament.
- ◆ The organizing committee reserves the right to alter rules or make amendments due to unforeseen circumstances at a later stage.
- ◆ Teams must be accompanied by the Physical Education Director (PED) or team manager, who will be responsible for the team's behaviour.

- ◆ Fixtures will be shared with the team captains on the first day of the tournament. No requests for changes to the fixtures will be entertained.
- ◆ Metal-studded shoes are strictly prohibited on the playing field.

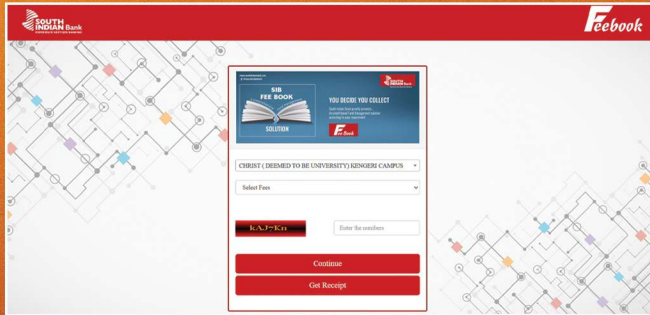
