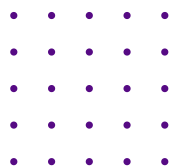
OBJECTIVES

DESCRIPTION

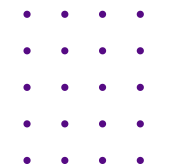
