Most of the administrative and management processes like selection process, admission process, fees payment, students attendance with extracurricular, complete examination process from time table to results, hostel admission and daily attendance, Digital repository of questions, placements, staff appraisal, internal audit process etc. can be done online. The process for syllabus upload, course plan, internal assessment details are also done through this software. The system also has an integration to payment gateways, messaging interfaces, signature device, biometric device etc. which are used for various purposes. Students can submit various support requests, certificates, transcript etc. online and get notifications on completion. This system plays a crucial role to streamline various administrative processes. The KP has 44 modules and 900 sub modules. Feedback Obtained

Structured feedback is received from all stake holders on curriculum: Outgoing UG and all the PG students assess the curriculum using online feedback forms. Their independent reports are taken for analysis. Course teachers give their comments on the curriculum of the paper they handle. Feedback on the entire syllabus is obtained from the alumni of respective departments. Identified parents are requested to give their feedback on the curriculum of their wards. Employers give feedback whether the curriculum meets their employability demands. Each department analyses the feedback. The analysis is sent to the Curriculum Development Cell (CDC). The CDC evaluates the feedback and necessary actions or modification in the curriculum are introduced in the department. Further these changes/recommendations are passed in the regulatory bodies for approval. Among the stake holders 19 percentage felt the curriculum is excellent , 48 percentage expressed as Good.

2.3.2 – Students mentoring system available in the institution? Give details. (maximum 500 words)

The University has a wellstructured system for student mentorship and support involving the faculty, counsellors, parents and peers. The Director of Student Affairs heads the student support and mentoring in the University related to attendance, discipline, grievances, extracurricular activities etc. The Director works in consultation with the Deans in matters of student support. The Deans, the HODs and the faculty members are involved in mentoring, remedial classes, tutorials for slow learners, programmes for advanced learners and overall wellbeing of the students in terms of academic and personal growth. The University has class teacher system, where each class is assigned a faculty to regularly oversee and coordinate student mentoring, attendance, discipline, grievances, learning difficulties, fee concessions, scholarships etc. Meetings with students are arranged by the class teacher upon request by the student or in case of any grievances/indiscipline the same is documented in a counselling/mentoring register. If a particular student requires professional support, the class teacher refers the student to the Centre for Counselling and Health Services. The Centre for Counselling and Health Services plays a key role in mentoring students who need psychological support. Peer mentoring is carried out on issues related to teenagers like rash driving, healthy living, healthy relationships etc. Every year the University trains a group of 200 peermentors who involve in both, group and individual mentoring. They regularly keep in touch with the Counsellors. The Centre also conducts specific programmes like Induction counselling for the newly joined students, personal counselling, psycho educational sessions on managing time, relationships, selfesteem, body image, addictions and other topics of relevance to youth. Interactive sessions are also conducted with students to improve their psychosocial competence in areas such as personal safety, addictions, anger management, managing emotions, fostering relationships etc. The University involves the parents in the academic progress and disciplinary matters of the students. Parent Faculty meetings are held twice a year at the end of each semester to address general concerns with a comprehensive representation of parent members, the management, faculty representatives and counsellors in order to review the activities of the University regarding their wards and discuss any concerns of major importance. For International Students, apart from the above mentioned system, the Director, International Office regularly meets students and monitors their progress and needs.

• Quality improvement of faculty: The University has taken steps to ensure that by the next NAAC accreditation more than 90 of the faculty have PhD. Accordingly, PhD has been made mandatory for all regular recruitment to faculty positions. Further, the existing faculty who have registered for PhD are given support and encouragements to complete their PhD in time. The faculty who have not enrolled for PhD have been individually counselled at the departmental level by the Office of Personnel Relations to enrol and complete their PhD in time. Further quality improvement programmes and training programmes are aligned towards research project writing and publications. • Enhancement of Research: The University enhanced its emphasis on applying for research projects, and publication in UGC listed journals. Talks and workshops were organised to encourage faculty to write applications for research grants to external funding agencies. The University also put thrust on developing joint research grant applications to foreign research funding agencies with foreign

universities with which it has MOUs. The University has asked all faculty to have at least one Scopus publication in the following academic year. The University has spent considerable amount of money to buy research equipment to promote better faculty research in the areas of basic science, engineering and psychology. The University initiated the process to establish a separate cell for patent filing support. • Consultancy: The University initiated steps to establish consultancy cells in all its academic departments and also initiate capacity building workshops for consultancy. Steps were also taken to publicise about the University consultancy strengths on the University website and through its institutional networks.

7.1.2 – Environmental Consciousness and Sustainability/Alternate Energy initiatives such as:

Percentage of power requirement of the University met by the renewable energy sources

Use of renewable energy: The use of solar energy has been promoted extensively in the hostels to provide lighting and water heating and reduce the dependence on electricity and promote usage of green and alternate energy. Also, replacement of incandescent light with CFL and from CFL to LED, use of solar water heaters, passive solar building design and energyefficient windows have all contributed energy efficiency programme in the campus. A total of three biogas plants have been set up in the campus, which convert food waste generated in the hostel and other eateries, into close to 750 kg of Biogas or 338 kg LPG every month that supplies gas to the kitchen. Additionally, live demo water jacket model of biotech and ARTI model biogas plants at CHRIST (Deemed to be University) are created for demonstration and training to various stakeholders. The average use of water is about 4 lakh litres per day. Out of this 3 Lakh litres of water are recycled through rainwater harvesting and sewage treatment. This recycled water is used for irrigation of plants and flushing of restrooms. Water harvesting and Check Dam construction: Water harvesting systems established in CHRIST (Deemed to be University) is unique in all aspects. In the Main Campus, every day about 300000 litres of greywater is treated and used for vegetation and gardening. Rainwater harvesting promoted in the Kengeri Campus location is one of the unique features of judicious utilization of water resource. With the concept of "catch rainwater where it falls", the University ensures recharging of groundwater in both the campus locations. Rooftop rainwater and runoff water are channelized through a system and collected in a sump tank and used for watering the garden. Check dams have been constructed by the University as part of the communitybased watershed and soil conservation intervention in Jiwati Taluk, Chandrapur district of Maharashtra which has immensely benefitted the people of 24 villages for sustainable agriculture, animal husbandry and livelihood promotion. Several initiatives are taken by the University to make the campus ecofriendly. Centre

for Social Action has established recycling plant, handmade paper unit, biogas plant, water harvesting and energy conservation systems. The University campus is blessed with several hundreds of flowering trees along with other shrubs and herbs which beautify the landscape and improve the atmosphere of the place with their beautiful flowers and glossy leaves. The air quality in and around the campus is without much of vehicular pollution due to the widespread greenery around. A polyhouse within the campus is used to rear a large variety of flowering plants, which in turn contribute to a green and pleasant ambience within the campus. Regular flora and fauna audits are carried out to keep an eye on the biodiversity/species richness on the campus.

7.3 – Institutional Distinctiveness

7.3.1 – Provide the details of the performance of the institution in one area distinctive to its vision, priority and thrust in not more than 500 words

Centre for Social Action: Centre for Social Action (CSA) is the development wing of CHRIST (Deemed to be University). It was set up in 1999 to coordinate social sensitization programmes for students and undertake community development projects for marginalized communities. It was intended to enable the student community to imbibe the values of social responsibility, as envisaged in the Core Values, Vision and the Mission of Christ University. It is a student movement for a humane and just society with children as the primary focus. CSA addresses issues related to child rights, socioeconomic development of women, youths and farmers, community mobilization and environment/climate change issues. Among the many activities it conducted the university wishes to mention one Village adoption. The University adopted the following six villages: Yelachammanahalli, Appasandara, Govindapura, Gonakanahalli, Thaggali Hosahalli, Doddathaggali in the outskirts of Bangalore. The following were the outcomes.

1. Women's Cooperative Bank: The Women's Cooperative Bank was set up by Chethana Women and Community Development Multipurpose Cooperative Society Limited, a community based organization, which was initiated, established and strengthened by CHRIST (Deemed to be University) in Yelachammanahalli. The bank began its operation from 7th February 2019. It caters to around 650 women belonging to 55 Self Help Groups of women from 14 villages. CHRIST (Deemed to be University) is continuing to provide technical support to the bank.

2. Modification of Drinking Water Borewell Recharge Pit in Yelachammanahalli: This intervention carried out in February 2019 is helping 40 families in the village to get potable water. The borewell was the only source of drinking water for the 40 families. The recharge pit was modified by placing a steel mesh in between two layers of 2 mm stones. Charcoal placed in between the layers earlier was done away with as it gets destroyed within three to four years. The damaged stone materials were removed and replaced with new ones. The community people especially women provided the labour and they pledged to manage the recharge pit by themselves from henceforth. The water that was not potable

before the modification work has become potable now and the water levels are likely to increase after the rains. 40 families are getting benefited. 3. Desilting of Check Dam in Yelachammanahalli: In the same village, a Check Dam was desilted in March 2019. This will help in recharging the ground and surface water. As a result of the desilting work, water collected in the natural water canal, which is around 2km long leading to the check dam, will be useful for the people and the cattle. 4. Construction of a Drinking Water Borewell Recharge Pit in Thaggali Hosahalli: In Thaggali Hosahalli village, the drinking water bore well recharge pit, which was constructed in March 2019 is catering to 50 families. The water levels will increase after the rains and will not get too low during the summer. 5. Solar cum Electric Powered 'Fan Gasifier Smokeless Chullah Production Unit' The smokeless chullah production unit is a collaborative effort of the University , (through Centre for Social Action).

8.Future Plans of Actions for Next Academic Year

The University future plan aims at making the Institution a worldclass University that addresses both the local and global needs. In order to achieve this strategic goal, the university has made the following plans. In order to enhance teacher quality, the University will continue its efforts to recruit faculty with PhD, especially with PhD from abroad and follow up with the faculty who have not completed PhD to complete their PhD. The University will also identify researchintensive faculty who do have international exposure and give them international exposure by supporting their travel to seminars and also finding shortterm teaching assignments with its collaborating foreign universities. Teacher Certification course in teaching, curriculum development and research will be started which will be mandatory for all the new teachers. The University will focus on the improvement and internationalising of the curriculum of its existing programmes and explore the possibility of introducing programmes in emerging areas. Focussed efforts will be made to obtain research grants in collaboration with collaborating Universities abroad. In order to better support and boost incubation, consultancy and patent filing, the University will establish Office of Incubation, consultancy and patents with expert staff. To boost research on campus, PhD enrolment will be increased. A separate Research Block will be constructed to accommodate the PhD Scholars and faculty research with advanced research facilities. The University will galvanise its the efforts in alumni engagement in various activities of the university including obtaining financial support to the university activities. The year 202021 is the Golden Jubilee year of the Alumni Association. Hence the next year will initiate planning for the Golden Jubilee of the Alumni Association. Alumni will be engaged to create an Alumni Chair at the University. Collaboration with foreign universities will be harnessed for achieving the internationalisation efforts of the University. The MOUs will be geared towards collaborative research and faculty exposure. Off Campuses will be started in Pune and National Capital Region Delhi to improve access to quality education to other parts of the country, especially in liberal arts.
