

Description:

Investigative Psychology is the term used for the part of forensic psychology that deals with criminal investigation. An investigative psychologist works with the police in order to solve crimes by understanding the types of crimes and criminals. This includes understanding patterns in crimes, criminal behaviour in relation to past life and personal life dynamics. This event aims to include this side of psychological thinking where one must define patterns in behaviour and situations. It gives students universally (from all courses) a platform to practice their skill of discriminating between patterns of personality: it also enables them to be further trained in this skill through practice. Each team includes 3 participants.

Rounds: Participants have three rounds to work through before winning the game, one round per day. Each Day will also end with an elimination.

Canvas Tales



Description-

Canvas Tales is an art event in which participants will be given on the spot themes and they have to portray their ideas through any medium on the sheet provided. There will be no elimination in the rounds and a cumulative score will be taken after the third round to select the winners.

Dates- 9-11th February, 2017


Duration- 2.5 hours
