Manjunatha Dixit completed his BE in E&C from the University of Mysore in the year 1991. He completed his M.Tech from IIT Kharagpur with specialization in Integrated Circuits and Systems Engineering in the year 1994. He is working as an Engineering Manager with Intel for the past 15 years in the Server Microprocessor Design group. He currently manages a portfolio of complex digital IP blocks which are part of the next generation server microprocessors. Prior to his current role, Dixit was the manager for the logic design and verification teams which designed Intel's first Xeon-D server. For his work on the 10 core server processor code-named Eagleton, Dixit was awarded the Intel Achievement Award, the most prestigious team award at Intel. Prior to working at Intel, Dixit has worked at multiple multinational companies in India, France, Singapore and the USA. Dixit also holds an MBA in Operations Management from IGNOU and is currently pursuing his PhD in Business Administration from the Faculty of Management Studies and Research, Aligarh Muslim University. Dixit has published 4 research papers in international journals.
