Structure:

The programme was structured in a way to make it systematic and easy for the audience to

graphic PowerPoint presentations, with each individual speaker being allotted a timeframe of 8 -

12 minutes to elaborate on the topic. To reduce monotony, each session was concluded with few

intriguing quiz questions and a Q&A session with the audience.

Topics presented:

Preamble, Citizenship, Federal Form of Government, Fundamental Rights, Directive Principles of

State Policy, Judiciary, Executive, Legislature, Doctrine of Basic Structure, Emergency.

The Constitutional Law Orientation 2018 was a one-day orientation session on Constitutional law

in India, which was conducted by the Constitutional law Studies and Orientation Committee for

the Engineering Students of the Kengeri Campus of Christ University. The event consisted of

around 300 students and their respective head faculty members. The orientation session was taken by the members of the Committee where each member had explained the fundamentals of the Constitution of India. Quizzes were conducted after every session in order to make sure that the students were grasping the essentials of the Constitution, and their rights and duties which every Indian citizen must be aware about.
