EVENT 1: DENOVO

DeNovo is a talent search event organized by the Cultural Committee for the 1st year students where they compete against classes of their batch which also acts as an ice breaking activity for them but, this year DeNovo also had performances by 2nd year students of School of Law, CHRIST (Deemed to be University). It was conducted on the 9th of July, 2018 at 2pm in the Main Auditorium. The judges for this event were Ms. Laxmi Menon and Mr. Jonas Monteiro. During the event, members of the University Student Council, inducted a brief of deanery level student council members, for the academic year 2018-19. The theme for DeNovo 2018 was based on a culmination of cultures of various countries. Each class had been allotted a country which they represented through music, dance or drama performances. The results were announced by the judges for the event along with Father Benny Thomas, Director, School of Law,

CHRIST (Deemed to be University) and handed over the prizes to the winners. LLM was the overall winner for the event and won a very attractive gift hamper for all the participants of their batch.
