Dr Sweta Mukherjee and Dr Suparna Majumdar Kar from the Teaching Learning Enhancement Cell at Christ University conducted a workshop on Outcome Based Education and Constructive Alignment for faculty at the Union Christian College Shillong Meghalaya on December 9 and 10, 2021. This two-day workshop was offered in an offline format on campus in Meghalaya and will be followed by online sessions in 2022.

Workshop Outcomes

At the end of the workshop participants should be able to:

- Use outcome-based language to review programme outcomes, develop course outcomes and learning outcomes and align them to the Vision and Mission of the institution
- Review a course that they are currently teaching in terms of constructive alignment
- Constructively align a course that they teach in a hybrid format
- Demonstrate an understanding of the concepts of Universal Design for Learning
- Adapt these to teaching in hybrid classrooms
- Adopt Service Learning

Workshop Schedule

Time: 9:30 AM- 2: 30 PM

Day 1: December 9, 2021

- Introduction to Learning Outcome-based Curriculum Framework
- Constructive alignment in Higher Education
- UDL in Higher Education

Day 2: December 10, 2021

- Teaching and assessment in a hybrid format
- Service-Learning in higher education

The two-day workshop focussed on providing hands-on training on designing learning outcomes for programmes and course outcomes, pedagogy in Hybrid and online classrooms, Universal Design on Learning, and incorporating service-learning into the curriculum.

The first day of the workshop started with understanding current practices at UCC, Shillong. This was followed by a detailed discussion on curriculum design and constructive alignment in the curriculum which is the basis of an outcome based curriculum. The National Education Framework was also discussed, followed by a detailed session on programme and course outcomes. The day concluded with a session on Universal Design for Learning and its incorporation into pedagogy for classrooms. The sessions also included participants designing learning outcomes for their respective courses, and assessment for the same to understand constructive alignment

The second day of the workshop began with a discussion on Hybrid classrooms. The deliberations included discussions on ways in which pedagogy and curriculum in the Hybrid

classrooms can be made inclusive using the notions of Universal Design for Learning, and be constructively aligned. The participants were also introduced to Revised Bloom's Taxonomy, and backward design. Participants worked on aligning course outcomes with assessment learning outcomes and pedagogy. The second half of the session focussed on the incorporation of service-learning into the curriculum. The session included deliberations on ways in which service-learning is incorporated into the curriculum in other institutions, focussed on ways in which service-learning is integrated into the curriculum at CHRIST and concluded with suggestions for incorporation of service-learning into the curriculum at UCC Shillong. The workshop concluded with a formal valedictory programme organized by UCC, Shillong. The interaction between TLEC and faculty at UCC Shillong will continue on the google classroom platform that participants have access to.
