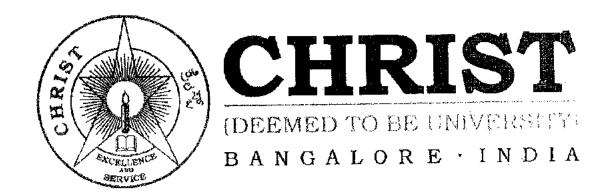

#### 1. Introduction

#### 1.1 Background

### 2. Standard Operating Procedure

#### Office Bearers

There are four student office bearers of ACII

- President
- Vice President
- o Secretary
- o Treasurer

A Faculty coordinator will be assigned by the Head of the Department, Department of Computer Science and Engineering for coordinating the activities of ASCII

## 2.1 Eligibility for Office Bearers

- 2.1.1 One office bearer will be selected from each Section of CSE and IT and will be designated as President/Vice-president/Secretary/Treasurer.
- 2.1.2 Students having 85 % of attendance and First Class in their academics are eligible to apply.
- 2.1.3 Student should have actively participated in the ASCII activities till fourth semester.
- 2.1.4 Only fifth semester students are eligible for office bearer positions.
- 2.1.5 The tenure of office bearers will be for one academic year.
- 2.1.6 Student should possess leadership qualities.
- 2.1.7 Student should not hold any other position in any of the club/professional Society.

#### 2.2 Activities

- 2.2.1 Based on the expertise of students, peer to peer workshops will be conducted by the students for the students. All these workshops will be conducted after the regular working hours of the university.
- 2.2.2 Suggestions will be gathered from students to identify the areas which the students need hands on and technical talks. Based on the student's requirement, technical talks or hands-on sessions will be arranged.
- 2.2.3 Students will be motivated to participate in all technical fests and Hackathons.
- 2.2.4 Flagship event of ASCII, Foobar will be organized in the even semester.
