The curriculum will consist of classroom instruction, Excursions & company visits, and/or European cultural.

Participants will select 1 program track from the following:

TRACK 1: EUROPEAN CULTURE, BUSINESS & ENTREPRENEURSHIP

The course is suitable for all students who are interested in learning more about European culture, entrepreneurship, doing business in Europe and in developing their personal skills. During this short course student will participate in interactive workshops that focus on skills and personal development in both entrepreneurial and general topics. Company visits and cultural excursions are also included.

TRACK 2: SUPPLY CHAIN MANAGEMENT

Students interested in learning more about international supply chain are invited to join this short course. Classes are tutorial-style and students work in small groups on a final project: a full redesign of a mock Western European supply chain. Eligibility Criteria – Summer School

- An overall aggregate of CGPA 3.2 or higher
- Must be a CHRIST undergraduate student currently enrolled in classes
- Must have completed one year in CHRIST
- Complete the application form and get approval from your department HoD/Coordinator
- Demonstrate your ability to support your stay overseas through a financial plan
- Satisfy host institution and country entry requirements
- Be a good ambassador for the CHRIST (Deemed to be University)

Cost: € 1500

- Accommodation (twin room) + breakfast
- Transport between accommodation and campus on week days
- Excursions & company visits
- All study materials
- Welcome and farewell meal
- Health & liability insurance for the duration of the program
