

## **Address by Vishal Nagpal**



## **Open forum- Experience Sharing**


### **Bhuvan G.M (Batch of 1994)**


### **Jonathan Ambrose: (Batch of 2004)**




### **Mallika Dasgupta: (Batch of 2004)**
