The three days workshop began with an inaugural function where the resource persons were formally welcomed and introduced by the Faculty from Maris Stella College. This was followed

by a short speech by the principal Dr. Sr. Jasintha Quadras elaborating on the relevance of Outcome Based Education.

The first day of the workshop focussed on defining the concepts of Learning Outcome Based Curriculum Framework, instructional design and Course Plans. Towards the later half of the day, the participants were asked to work on the shared course plan template and start the process of designing their course plans with specific focus on designing course outcomes. All the participants were signed into the google classroom and had to work on this platform for the next three days.

On the second day, the participants continued to work on their course plans focusing extensively on the construction of Course Outcomes based on the reviews given by the resource persons at the end of Day 1. The session continued with inputs from the resource persons on Assessment Outline, designing assignments, learning outcomes for the assignments and the mapping of the Course Outcomes and assessment components. The assignments designed were peer-reviewed along with inputs from the resource persons.

The third and final day of the workshop was categorized into two distinct sessions. The first half of the day was dedicated to the framing of the programme outcomes, programme specific outcomes for the departments and the different programmes and reviewing these. The session after lunch was conducted by Mr Vinay M who provided details on digital resources that can be available and how to use them to facilitate digitally enhanced classrooms. The workshop ended by participants providing feedback on the three day workshop.
