**Font:** Times New Roman

**Font Size:** 12

**Line Spacing:** 1.5

The abstract should be mailed to **csasdgseminar@gmail.com**.

Papers shall be accepted only in **English**.

**The following details must be included:**

**Title of the paper:** Times New Roman, 14 Font, Bold.

**Theme:** Must indicate the theme/s under which Goal the paper is submitted.

**Author Details:** Name with the title (Prof./Dr./Mr./Ms.), The department, Affiliation, Email ID, and Mobile Number.

**Keywords:** 3 to 5 keywords relevant to the concerned research.

**References:** Include references used for the review of literature in APA format.

**The abstract must include the following:**

- The central theme of the paper
- Objectives of the paper
- Significance of the research
- Methodology - whether used primary/secondary research
- Results/concluding statements/insights

**Important Dates**

Last date of submission of abstract (through email): **12 October 2020**

Intimation of Acceptance of Abstracts (through email): **Within 3 days** of the submission.

**Note:** Selected candidates must submit the full paper (of 1000 words length, in APA format) by **5 November 2020**. Followed by this, candidates whose papers are selected will present their papers virtually at the conference with a time limit of **8 + 2 minutes**.
