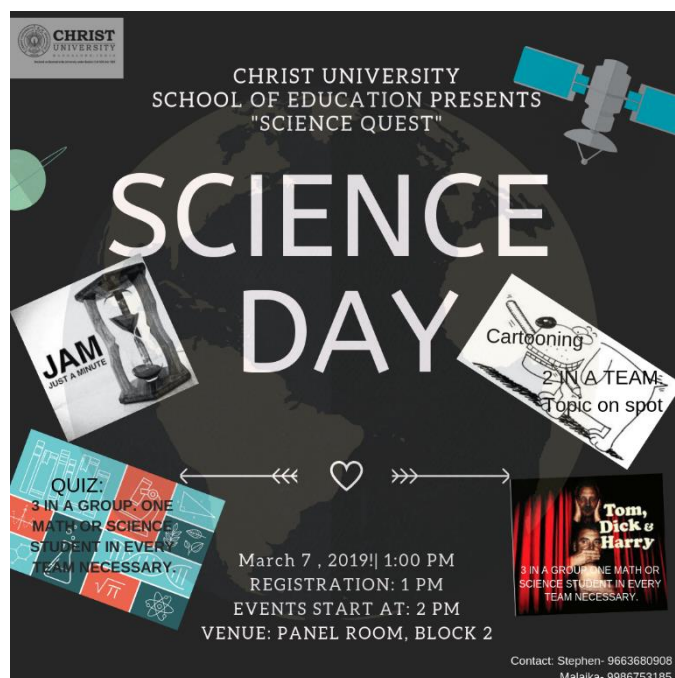


Science Day Report

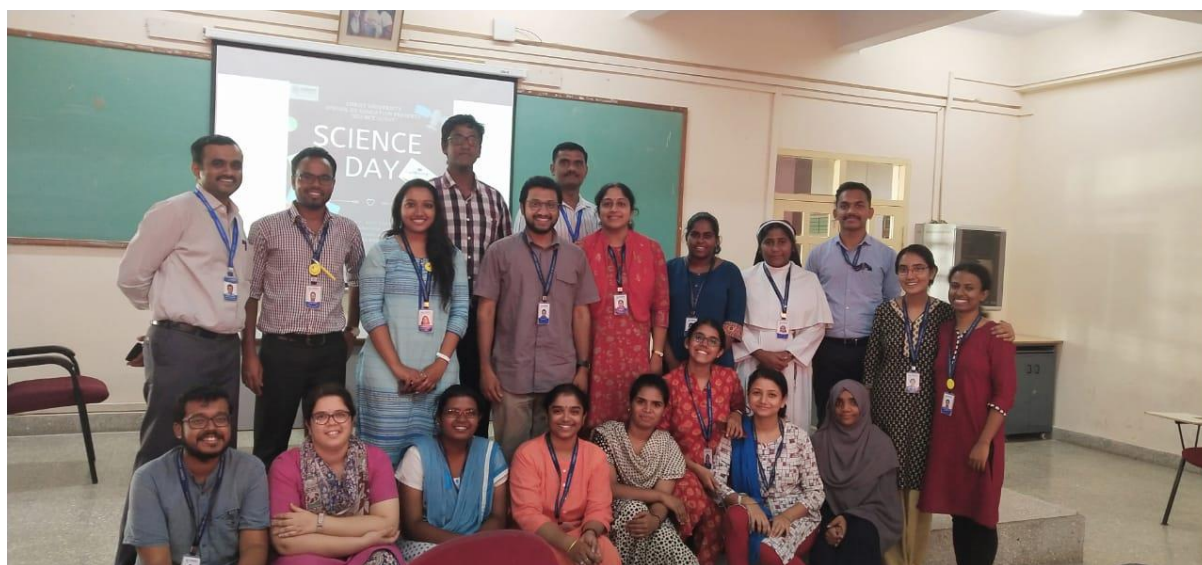
