











The session started with a presentation on the guidelines which help in the construction of effective MCQs. The presentation was followed by a 15 minute time period where the teams were divided subject wise and were asked to review their existing MCQs based on Bloom's taxonomy (revised) and the parameters shared for framing MCQs. The teams then presented their review. The teams were then given one hour to rework their MCQs based on the parameters given. All the reworked assignments were sent to the TLC mail followed by a presentation by the teams. Feedback was provided by TLC and the other faculty members (participants). This session was followed by feedback from the participants. A feedback form was also circulated and the participants were requested to fill the form.
