The University

Christ University, established as Christ College in 1969, was born out of the educational vision of St Kuriakose Elias Chavara, an educationalist and a social reformer of the nineteenth century. It became an autonomous College in 2005 and a deemed to be university in 2008. The University with its focus on teaching, learning and research offers bachelors, masters and doctoral programmes in Sciences, Humanities, Social Sciences, Commerce, Management, Engineering, Law, and Education. The university currently has around 16,000 students and 750 faculty members.

Centre For Education Beyond Curriculum (CEDBEC)

The Centre, an initiative of Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), has been conceived as an attempt to stimulate and rediscover through experience, the perspectives in education so that individuals and institutions reflect and rediscover themselves and move towards a sustainable progress in the educational arena.

Background

Teaching at the university level never required any formal pedagogical education until recently. (Hannan & Silver) Studies reveal the development of teaching pass through three phases- individual, guided and directed. The Individual phase is marked by the teacher's personal enthusiasm to experiment with new teaching methods. The guided phase is an attempt by the institution to strengthen and develop the faculty for institutional growth and to make them accountable. The method of directing is a policy driven one

that enables faculty to reflect, experiment and adopt pragmatic approaches to teaching. In the context of the above discussion, this workshop aims at initiating a discourse on professionalization of teaching focusing on excellence and improving the pedagogical competence of the teachers considering the individual, guided and directed phases of development of teaching. This will enable them to handle the challenges in line with the rapid expansion of classroom demands. This will also shift the concern from elite to a democratic nature. Who will be the key players in the formulation of the new pedagogical practices and training of university/college teachers? Will it be achieved without compromising on excellence in teaching? Will it be considered as a perceived need for a new kind of pedagogical competence sufficient to handle the consequences of the rapid expansion of higher education in recent years? These and many other questions will be dealt with during the discourse.
