EVENT: St. Mary School - Lingua-Bee Workshop

Report:

The lingua bee workshop was an initiative conducted by CAPS, in collaboration with St. Mary's school, Rajkot. As a part of this program, CAPS volunteers took sessions with students of grade 5 and 6 on 7th November, 2020. Over the course of this two day workshop, the students were asked to do various exercises, with our CAPS volunteers aimed at improving their spoken and written English, and gain insight into the basics of effective communication. The students were divided into groups of 20+ assigned to our volunteers. On day 1, a one hour session was conducted for students of grade 5. All the participants engaged in interactive activities and they attempted various activities and regularly asked questions and participated very well in the session. On day 2, the volunteers conducted another session for students of grade 6. For day 2, students were first introduced to the concepts, followed by an icebreaker activity. The topic at hand for day 2 was focused on tips and strategies to improve communication skills, participants were asked to create dialogue based on cues given by the volunteers. The purpose of this exercise was to teach the students the basic principles of communication, language syntax and grammar rules they have to keep in mind while framing sentences.
