Overview

At the end of the event, the students and some mentors were also delighted with the outcome of the event, as they mentioned it was one of the liveliest events of the EEP.

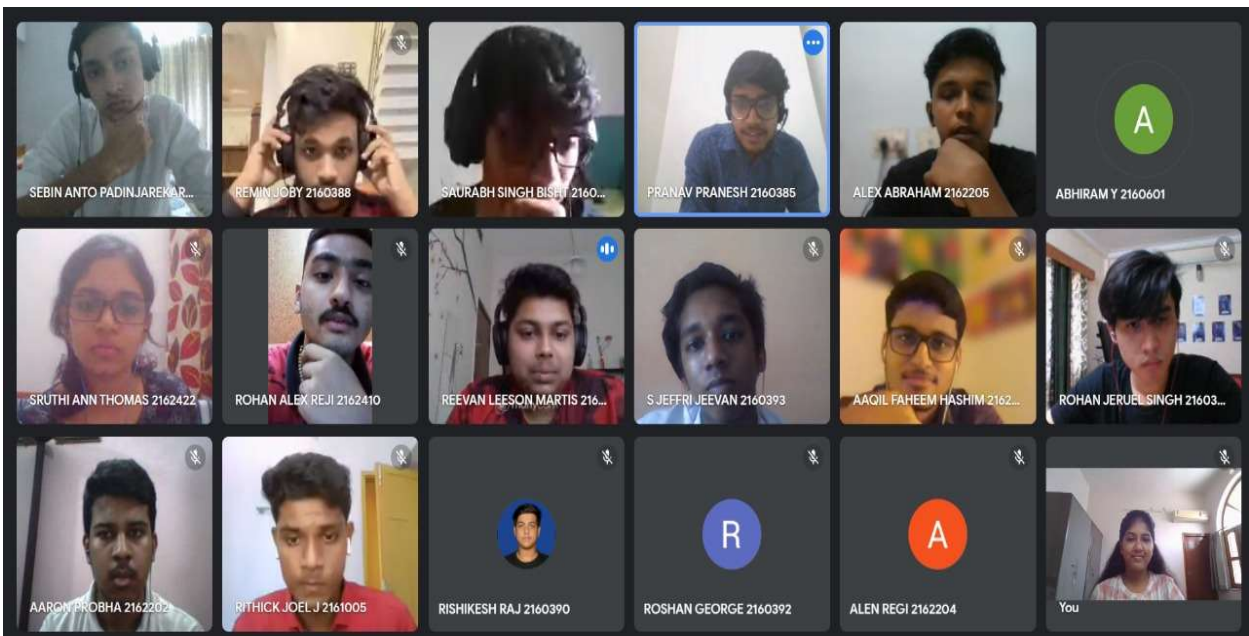
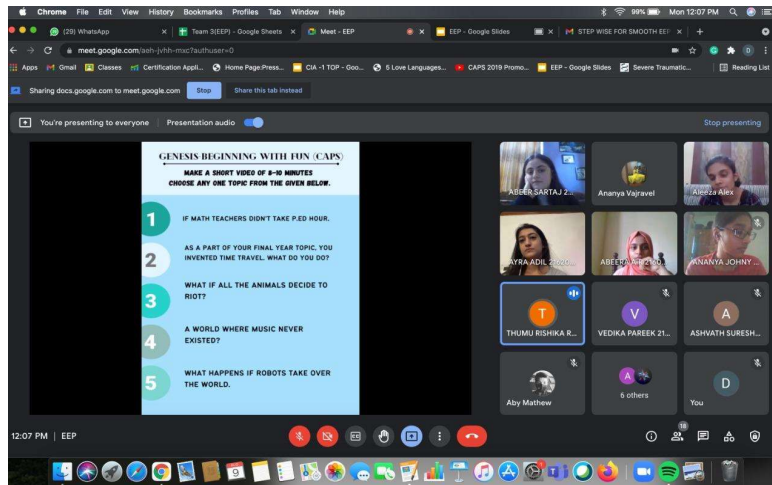
Problems/Issues Faced
