### PARTICULARS

- Entrance Test (ET): 90 Minutes except if otherwise specified
- Skill Assessment (SA): Candidates will be asked to write on a given topic for not more than one A4 size sheet and for not more than 10 minutes.
- Micro Presentation (MP): Candidate should be able to talk for 90seconds, on a topic given by the panel.
- Personal interview (PI): duration: 10 minutes
- **The selection process (SA\_MP\_PI) will be held in person at the venue selected while submitting the application form online.**

- As per E Admit Card (Admit card will be issued **2-3 days before** the scheduled date)

### SELECTION PROCESS MODE

- **Entrance Test:** ONLINE
- **SA\_MP\_PI:** VENUE BASED

### IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS:

- Academic Performance: Applicants must upload all the qualification-related documents (Class 10, 12, Undergraduate Degree Marks Card (Semester/Year/Consolidated), and specific document pertaining to the programme), while filling the application online. \*Applications with no mark's cards, other mandatory documents or unclear scanned copies will be rejected and termed as Not Eligible.
- The date and time for the selection process are auto-generated by the system. Therefore, any request for changes will not be entertained.
- Candidates are requested to regularly check their application status for all communications related to the application, selection, and admission process.
- Please note that no email or SMS communication will be sent regarding updates on the ET\_SA\_MP\_PI date and time.
- Candidates may prepare their travel plan as per the "Important Dates Section" and book the travel tickets well in advance in order to avoid disappointment in losing an opportunity to appear in the selection process.
- Candidates failing to appear for the selection process at the stipulated date and time will be considered as "Not Selected".
- Candidates must carry a copy of the admit card, all original mark cards, and a valid photo identity proof for verification at any stage of the selection process. Failure to produce these documents will result in the application being considered as "**Not Selected.**"
- Candidates are advised to log in to the Entrance Test link at least 30 minutes before the scheduled time to avoid any last-minute technical issues.
- Candidates are expected to report to the selection process (SA\_MP\_PI) venue on the allotted date and at least 30 minutes prior to the time mentioned in the admit card.
- Impersonation or any suspicious behaviour (prompting by a third person or accessing notes/gadgets) will be treated as malpractice and the application will be termed as "Not Selected".
- The responsibility of satisfying the eligibility criteria for admission rests with the student/candidate. The issue of the E-Admit Card for the selection process does not imply that the eligibility criteria are satisfied.
- Entrance test duration: 60 & 90 Minutes except if otherwise specified.
- Admit card issued 2 to 3 days prior to the scheduled date.
