## ACADEMIC INFORMATION

Entire program is designed to help students relax, enjoy the city and get to know fellow summer students. Activities might include dinners out, a local boat tour, evening socials and day trips to explore some of the fabulous cities in the region.

## **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA – Bristol Summer School**

- An overall aggregate of CGPA 3.0 or higher
- Must be a CHRIST undergraduate student currently enrolled in classes
- Must have completed one semester/one year in CHRIST
- Demonstrate your ability to support your stay overseas through a financial plan
- Satisfy host institution and country entry requirements
- Be a good ambassador for the CHRIST (Deemed to be University)
