

COURSE DETAILS AND ASSESSMENT GUIDELINES
ENVIRONMENTAL STUDIES (EVS)
Academic Year 2026-27

Environmental Studies (EVS) is a mandatory Value-Added Course for all undergraduate students in their first semester as per the National Education Policy (NEP). The course carries one credit and aims to develop students' understanding of environmental issues and sustainability.

1. Course Access

The EVS course will be delivered online via the CHRIST MOOC platform: <https://mooc.christuniversity.in>

Students must use their KP login credentials to access the platform. Kindly ensure these credentials are available and active.

2. CIA Test Access

Continuous Internal Assessments (CIAs) will be conducted on the LMS Moodle platform: <https://courses.christuniversity.in>

Login is through the KP username and password.

3. Course Structure

The course is organised into five Units, with materials provided in various formats:

Video Lectures

Lecture Notes

Supplementary Readings and Resources

CIA 1 will cover Units I and II

CIA 2 will cover the remaining units

4. Assessment Overview

The evaluation consists of two CIAs:

CIA 1 - Scheduled from July 20 to 25, 2026

CIA 2 - Scheduled from Aug 17 - 22, 2026

Each CIA will carry 25 marks and will be conducted in a computer lab. A schedule of the same would be shared.

Duration: 30 minutes

Questions will be Multiple-Choice Type (MCQs)

Ensure you click "Submit" after completing the test to record your responses successfully.

5. Passing Criteria

There is no minimum mark requirement for individual CIA components. However, students must secure a minimum of 40% in aggregate (out of 50) across both CIAs to pass the course. Attendance in both CIAs is mandatory. Absence in either component will result in an automatic fail, regardless of performance in the other.

6. Repeat CIA / Supplementary Examination

Students who are unable to attend a CIA for valid reasons must obtain prior permission from the Controller of Examinations to be eligible to repeat it.

Repeat CIA Fees: ₹500 per component (applicable only within the same semester).

Supplementary Exam Fees: ₹2500 (applicable if registering in subsequent semesters).

Note: It is mandatory to pass the EVS course to be declared PASS in the semester.
