World Environment Day Plantation Drive- Summary


On 5th June 2025, the SDG Cell of Christ University, in collaboration with E-Cure, organized a plantation drive to commemorate World Environment Day. The event commenced with an inaugural address by Rev. Dr. Fr. Varghese K.J., Pro-Vice Chancellor, who also planted the first sapling within the university campus.

Over 250 students attended the inauguration, including all students of 3EMS (B.Sc. Economics, Mathematics, and Statistics), along with other volunteers from across the university. Participants took a pledge to protect and nurture the environment before proceeding to the plantation site near Dairy Circle and Forum Mall, where 80 volunteers actively planted 50 saplings.

Mr. David, Director of E-Cure, provided the saplings and tools, guiding the students throughout the activity. Dr. Leena James and Ms. Uma, SDG Cell coordinators, managed logistics and ensured smooth coordination.

The event emphasized hands-on environmental action, aligning with SDG 13 (Climate Action) and SDG 15 (Life on Land). It fostered a strong sense of responsibility and provided practical experience in sustainability, reinforcing Christ University's ongoing commitment to ecological well-being and community-driven initiatives.
















