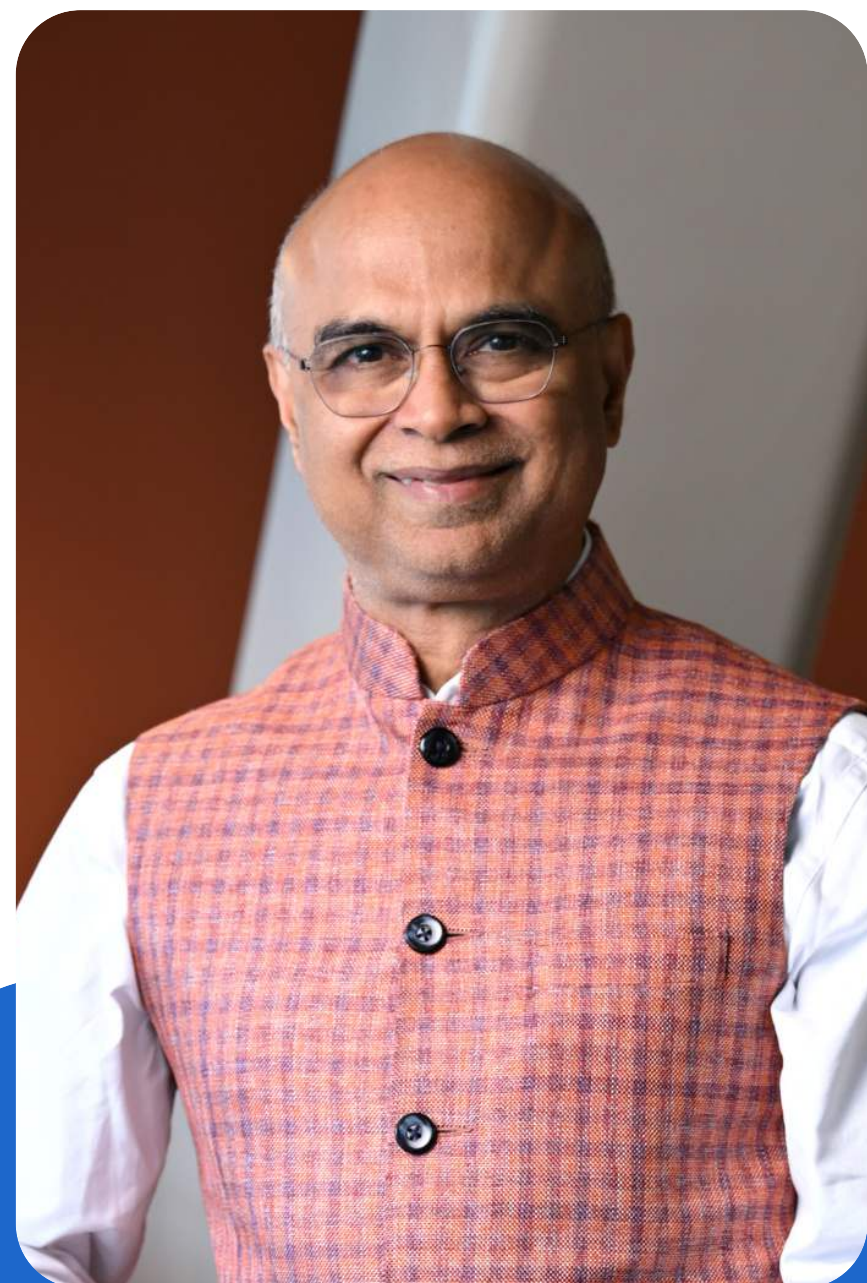

Dress Code

- Graduates are expected to adhere to the specified dress code by following the CHRIST Dress Code policy.
- Male students: White shirt, black trousers, and tie
- Female students: White or off-white saree

Reporting & Attendance Procedures

- Morning Session Students: Graduates must report directly to the Central Block. Please ensure you arrive before 9:00 AM and proceed to the classrooms mentioned on page 11.
- Afternoon (AN) Session Students & Parents: Graduates and their guests must initially report to the Management Block before 12:30 PM. Complimentary shuttle bus transportation will be provided to transfer attendees to the Central Block at the designated time. Upon arrival at the Central Block, students must report directly to the classrooms mentioned on page 11 at 1:00 PM.

PROTOCOL AND DECORUM DURING THE CEREMONY

Collection of Rob:

- Students must submit their University ID Cards and acknowledge the receipt of robes by providing their signatures to their gown distributors.
- Students arriving after the specified time for the morning and afternoon sessions will be denied permission to attend the convocation.
- Students are strictly not permitted to go outside the campus after collecting their robes.
- Throwing caps is strictly prohibited.

Procession:

- During the procession, students are to wear robes and caps compulsorily.
- Students are to maintain complete silence during the procession.
- Students and guests are expected to remain standing as the procession of dignitaries, led by the Registrar with the National Flag and the Controller of Examinations with the Christ University Flag, enters the venue.



Ceremony:

- Students will receive the convocation folder from the dignitaries in the same order as their seating in the ceremonial venue.
- Students should remember to greet the dignitaries after receiving the graduation folder.
- Students are to maintain complete silence during the ceremony.
- Professional photographers will capture photographs of all students receiving their convocation folders. To avoid obstructing the audience's view and disrupting the ceremony, personal photography in front of the stage or within the audience area is not permitted. We kindly request all attendees to cooperate.
- Please do not use mobile phones during the ceremony. Put your phones on silent mode.

Return of Robes:

- Morning Session: Academic robes must be returned to the classrooms mentioned on page 12 immediately following the conclusion of the session.
- Afternoon (AN) Session: Academic robes must be returned to the same reporting venues as mentioned on page 12 immediately following the conclusion of the session..



PARENT & GUEST SEATING

- Limited additional seating has been arranged within the main ceremony hall to accommodate parents and relatives on a first-come, first-served basis. There is no reservation of seats. For all other guests, comfortable alternative viewing areas equipped with a live broadcast of the proceedings have been arranged. (Please refer to the sent email for better clarity)
- Ceremony Attendance & Decorum: Parents and relatives accommodated in the main venue (ground floor) are requested to remain seated in their designated areas for the entire duration of the proceedings. To maintain the solemnity and visual decorum of the occasion, partial attendance cannot be entertained, and guests must refrain from exiting the hall or moving toward the stage. Additionally, an uninterrupted environment must be strictly maintained; no disruptions should occur, particularly during the official processions of the dignitaries and graduates.



PARKING

- Morning Session: Parking is designated behind the CHRIST Residence and at the Celebration Ground.
- Afternoon (AN) Session: Parking is designated at the Management Block parking lot.
- Parents and guests who arrive early are requested to park near their accommodations. Shuttle buses will be arranged to transport guests between their accommodations and the reporting venues.

CAMPUS SECURITY & SAFETY REGULATIONS

- Personal Belongings: For safety and security reasons, graduates and guests are strictly prohibited from bringing luggage or large bags into the campus premises. All such belongings must be safely secured inside your personal vehicle or within your designated accommodation room.
