Founded in 1875 the Université Catholique De Lille is a comprehensive unique in France, characterized by interdisciplinary, anchored in humanist value, open to diversity and respectful of all opinions. It consists of 5 Faculties, 20 Grandes Ecoles, schools, and institutes and a hospital group. It is France's largest private not for profit university with an enrollment of 33000 students and 217-degree programs in 6 areas of study.

THE EUROPEAN SUMMER PROGRAM (ESP)

The aim of this program is to give students the opportunity to have a study abroad experience in summer at Lille, France.

In 2001, Université Catholique De Lille created the [European Summer Program](#). Every summer since, this program has been achieving its goal of giving international students the opportunity to study in the summer in a University at the heart of Europe. The program has become more and more successful with each passing year and has developed in terms of provision of courses and services offered to students. Students can choose from a large variety of electives. The programs offer academic courses taught in English or in French, utilizing the University's expertise in Arts & Humanities, Sciences, Business and Management, and more.

ACADEMIC INFORMATION

To guarantee the high level of teaching, classes are limited to 20 students per course. The program awards credits to students in accordance with the European Credit Transfer System (ETCS). The faculty staff members at the European Summer Program are all highly qualified in their discipline and use student-centered educational methods. A transcript is issued to all students at the end of the program indicating the courses taken, the number of contact hours, the grade and the number of ECTS credits achieved.

SCHOLARSHIP:

- **Actual fee** - Euros 3,450€ (1500 € tuition fees + 1600€ hospitality package + 350 € Administration fees)
- CHRIST Student will get waiver of €750 (Scholarship per student on tuition fees)
- **Final amount to be paid to the Lille, France = € 2700** (INR 2,83,586.40 approx.) as on 08 Jan - 1€ = ₹ 105.04

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA – EUROPEAN SUMMER PROGRAM (ESP)

- An overall aggregate of CGPA 3.0 or higher
- Must be a CHRIST undergraduate student currently enrolled in classes
- Must have completed one semester/one year in CHRIST
- Complete the application form and get approval from your department HoD/Coordinator Demonstrate your ability to support your stay overseas through a financial plan
- Satisfy host institution and country entry requirements
- Be a good ambassador for the CHRIST (Deemed to be University)
