Liverpool Hope University Summer Program – 2026

The Summer Program is designed for international students who wish to experience a combination of academic learning, cultural immersion, and social engagement in the UK. Students can choose from a range of themed academic courses offered during three-week blocks in May, June, and July. Each academic course includes expert-led lectures, cultural visits, social activities, and guided assessment tasks. Through this experience, students not only earn academic credit but also explore Liverpool, participate in community and cultural events, and build global competencies needed for future careers.

Academic Information

The 3-week summer courses run across two blocks between 10 May and 22 July 2026. Students may choose one course from various disciplines such as Business, Psychology, Arts, Education, Culture, Kinesiology, Social Care, or English Language. Each course includes 36 hours of academic teaching, cultural activities, and assessment tasks that enable students to earn 15 UK credits. Classes are taught by Liverpool Hope University faculty members, including senior academic staff and subject experts who actively publish research in their fields. The academic experience is designed to strengthen students' critical thinking, research abilities, teamwork, and communication skills.

Support and Social Activities

The summer program includes a well-planned mix of cultural visits and social activities to help students experience life in Liverpool and connect with peers from around the world. Activities may include visits to the Beatles Quarter, the Museum of Liverpool, the Slavery Museum, the Walker Art Gallery, and film screenings, games nights, sports activities, and pizza parties. Students stay in single-room university accommodation with access to communal spaces and student lounges. They also receive guidance from university staff and can make use of campus facilities such as the library, study areas, and cafés.

Students Will Have to Pay For

1. Airfare
2. Visa
3. Medical and travel insurance
4. Any personal expenses, Meals not included, or additional local travel
5. Optional London weekend trip (£460)

Program Fee Includes

1. Airport pick-up and drop-off (Manchester Airport to university accommodation)
2. Single-room accommodation at Aigburth Park (university accommodation)
3. Meals Included -Breakfast & Lunch (Mondays to Friday)
4. Entrance fees for key cultural and social visits
5. Pizza party and group social events
6. Academic teaching, assessments, and official transcript (US Academic Credits)

Eligibility Criteria

- Must be a CHRIST undergraduate student currently enrolled in classes
- Open to I and II year undergraduate students from all disciplines
- Must have completed at least one semester/one year at CHRIST
- Must demonstrate financial ability to support the trip
- Must satisfy host university and country entry requirements
- Must represent CHRIST (Deemed to be University) positively
- Selection is based on a first-come, first-served basis

Application Form and Due Date

- Interested students are required to complete the application form, obtain approval from their respective Department HoD/Coordinator, and submit the duly filled Clearly scanned form along with all necessary documents to the Office of International Affairs via email on or **before Wednesday, 18 February 2026**, by 05:00 PM (IST) via email to -
