# About Us

At CHRIST (Deemed to be University), we remain deeply committed to ensuring that every student has access to quality education and a supportive academic environment that fosters excellence. In alignment with this vision, the Scholarship and Fellowship Support Cell was established in 2020 under the Office of the Registrar. Since then, it has grown into a central hub for students seeking financial assistance and academic enrichment opportunities.

The Cell serves as a unified point of access for identifying, curating, and communicating scholarship and fellowship schemes offered by the University, Government bodies, and external organisations. Led by a dedicated Coordinator and supported by staff from various University offices, the Cell ensures smooth and efficient coordination across all processes from information dissemination to verification and approvals.

Throughout the year, the Cell keeps students informed about national and international scholarship and fellowship opportunities by sharing timely updates, eligibility guidelines, deadlines, and application procedures. By offering accurate and comprehensive information, the Cell empowers students to make informed decisions and pursue opportunities aligned with their goals.

A significant aspect of the Cell's work involves managing applications submitted through major government scholarship platforms, including the National Scholarship Portal (NSP), State Scholarship Portals (SSP), PM Vidya Laxmi Portal, Karnataka Labour Welfare Board schemes, e-Kalyan Jharkhand, Mukhyamantri Nishchay Swayam Sahayatha Bhata Yojana (MNSSBY) Bihar, and the West Bengal Student Credit Card Scheme (WBSCC). The team meticulously verifies applications, coordinates with offices, and ensures timely processing, thereby easing the administrative burden on students.

Through its continued efforts, the Scholarship and Fellowship Support Cell plays an integral role in promoting financial inclusion, supporting student well-being, and enabling academic achievement. Its work contributes to the University's larger mission of fostering holistic development and ensuring equitable access to higher education.

## A Note from the Cell

Since its inception, the impact of the Scholarship and Fellowship Support Cell has been both meaningful and measurable. The dedication of the team has led to a steady and impressive increase in the number of students benefiting from scholarships and fellowships. In the academic year 2024–25, a total of 14,935 students received financial support 14,504 through University-funded schemes and 431 through external organisations. This milestone reflects the Cell's sustained efforts to expand student access to financial assistance and streamline processes for maximum benefit.

We express our sincere gratitude to the University leadership, faculty members, and administrative staff for their unwavering support and collaboration. Their contributions strengthen the work of the Cell and enable us to reach more deserving students each year.

# Christ Scholarship and Fellowship Schemes

To encourage and reward outstanding academic and extracurricular performance, and to support students from diverse socio-economic backgrounds in accessing quality holistic higher education, CHRIST (Deemed to be University) offers institutional scholarships and freeships. Scholarships are typically awarded to final-year or final-semester undergraduate and postgraduate students based on their cumulative academic performance in the previous year or semesters.

However, students from other years or semesters may also be considered on a case-by-case basis, based on their application and supporting documents. The University also provides fee concessions and instalment options for eligible students. New scholarships may be introduced depending on current needs.

Students wishing to apply for these benefits must submit an application in the prescribed format to their Head of Department. The Head, after reviewing the applicant's academic performance and financial background, forwards the application to the Dean of the School, who then submits it to the Scholarship/Free Ship Award Committee. The committee's recommendations are sent to the Chief Finance Officer for final approval.

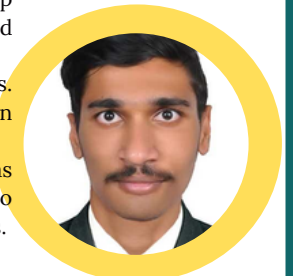
