ATTENDANCE ELIGIBILITY AND IMPORTANT DATES FOR CIA 2

Odd Semester, Academic Year 2026-27

As per the attendance policy, a **minimum of 75% attendance in each individual course** (including submission/multidisciplinary courses (MDC) with department-level assessments) is mandatory to be eligible to appear for CIA 2. This requirement is applicable to **all courses taught across all years.**

Important Dates for Eligibility Determination:

Applicable to all courses (except Multidisciplinary courses (MDC)) in UG/PG Programmes:

- Attendance recorded **up to 01 September 2026** will be considered for determining course-wise eligibility for the Mid-Semester Examinations / CIA 2.
- The **last date to submit the Co-Curricular Claim Form** to the respective offices is **29 August 2026.**
- Attendance with the co-curricular leaves will be published in the Student KP on **31 August 2026.**

Applicable to Multidisciplinary Courses (MDC) in UG Programmes:

- Attendance recorded **up to 25 September 2026** will be considered for determining the course-wise eligibility for the CIA 2.
- The **last date to submit the Co-Curricular Claim Form** to the respective offices is **18 September 2026.**
- Attendance with the co-curricular leaves will be published in the Student KP on **15 September 2026.**

Students who do not meet the 75% attendance requirement for a course or are absent may apply for a repeat CIA 2 in the concerned course(s) by paying the prescribed fee, as per university norms.

Students are advised to take note of the above details and ensure timely compliance.


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
