

Synopsis of the Activity (Description)

Highlights of the Activity	<p>Prarambh 2025 took place from June 28 to July 9, 2025 across Block 4 and the Central Block at Christ University. Over 14 days, first-year commerce students participated in two daily batches across six tracks—Human Resources, Finance, Public Relations, Marketing, Best Manager, and Business Quiz - engaging in simulation-based challenges that mirrored authentic industry scenarios. 4. Real-World Confidence
 - Participants faced investor Q&As, media scrutiny, and UN-style embargo debates, building composure and decision-making under scrutiny.
 - The Business Quiz's rapid-fire rounds kept students sharp on current affairs, brand insights and case-based problem solving.

 - By recreating authentic industry challenges, CUCA

Summary of the Activity	<p>Prarambh 2025 was an expansive, multi-vertical induction festival organized by the Christ University Commerce Association that immersed first-year commerce students in six core domains—Human Resources, Finance, Public Relations, Marketing, Best Manager, and the Business Quiz - through authentic, high-pressure simulations and case studies between June 28 and July 9, 2025. In Human Resources, participants confronted crisis-management scenarios - from reimagining the Avengers lineup and rescuing Kingfisher Airlines post-collapse to reforming Starbucks' anti-union backlash and addressing TikTok's discrimination scandal—learning to balance ethical leadership, transparent communication, and trauma-informed policy design while restoring morale and trust under tight time constraints. The Finance track challenged students with retirement portfolio construction, Olympic event financing, PSU disinvestment strategy, debt-restructuring for New World Development, insider-trading governance, M&A valuation in Cipla's acquisition of Stada, DeFi protocol design for Uniswap DAO, and post-collapse turnaround planning for Yamaichi</p>

Securities and LTCM, reinforcing the integration of rigorous financial modeling, ethical compliance, and strategic foresight in real-world markets.

Public Relations rounds tested crisis messaging for MrBeast's controversy, Google Gemini AI bias, greenwashing by Kimberly-Clark, McKinsey's political entanglements, Morocco's Western Sahara diplomacy, and historical scandals from Pfizer's drug trials to the 1934 Business Plot, honing participants' skills in narrative crafting, stakeholder analysis, media strategy, and ethical accountability. The Marketing division spanned 14 inventive rounds—stress tests, dark-tourism promotions, cult rebranding, haunted-hotel campaigns, surrogate advertising, Jet Airways' relaunch, auction-based resource allocation, digital storytelling, fantasy-kingdom product launches, and public-health crisis simulations - pushing teams to apply consumer psychology, design thinking, emotional resonance, and bold, unconventional strategies under pressure.

Best Manager, the leadership crucible, thrust students into executive roles where they navigated satellite-company debt revolts, airline brand rehabilitation, blood-diamond ethics frameworks, Viking settlement planning, Bollywood studio turnarounds, and culminated in a dual Shell-BP merger and green-energy restructuring, revealing the need for financial acumen, moral courage, persuasive storytelling, and resilience in ambiguity. Finally, the Business Quiz track fused brand recognition, current-affairs analysis, and rapid-fire case-based questions across four rounds - from global executive identification to market-trend puzzles, logo-and-tagline challenges, quarterfinal eliminations, and a fast-paced final - reinforcing foundational business literacy, analytical agility, and teamwork.

Across all six verticals, Prarambh 2025 compelled participants to integrate analytical frameworks (PESTEL, SWOT, NPV), ethical imperatives, and soft skills - communication, adaptability,

	collaboration - while thriving under relentless time constraints, equipping tomorrow's commerce professionals with the confidence and practical experience to excel in the dynamic world of business.


1. Descriptive report of the event for the website

The primary objective of Prarambh was to bridge the gap between theoretical learning and real-world application through simulation-based tasks, high-pressure decision-making, and scenario-driven challenges. Each event was structured to develop critical thinking, ethical reasoning, and strategic problem-solving, essential competencies in today's dynamic business environment. The Marketing Division explored branding, storytelling, and digital engagement through unconventional simulations, encouraging students to challenge traditional marketing paradigms. The Finance wing focused on investment planning, global M&A, crisis management, and fintech innovations, providing participants with a comprehensive view of the financial sector. In Public Relations, students navigated complex socio-political and corporate controversies, enhancing their crisis communication and reputation management skills. The Business Quiz promoted business literacy and quick decision-making through rounds centered on CEOs, branding, and current affairs. The Human Resource division engaged students with simulations of organizational crises, corporate ethics, and global diplomacy, emphasizing people-centric leadership. The Best Manager was the most rigorous event, placing participants in high-stakes executive roles to test their strategic acumen, adaptability, and ethical judgment. Overall, Prarambh 2025 served as a dynamic launchpad for students, fostering leadership, collaboration, and professional readiness. It successfully set the tone for the academic year by instilling a spirit of innovation, responsibility, and excellence among the participants.


How would you rate the overall experience of this event?

21 responses




How well were the logistics(timings,venue) managed?


How would you rate the difficulty level of the rounds?

21 responses




How clear were the instructions given to you?

3. Feedback Analysis

Prarambh conducted by CUCA for first-year students received encouraging feedback from 21 participants. The difficulty level of the rounds was rated at an average of 3.95, with 76.2% giving it 4 stars, suggesting the tasks were well-balanced—neither too easy nor too hard. The clarity of instructions also scored high with an average of 4.29, showing that the communication was clear and helped participants understand their roles and tasks. Similarly, the event environment was appreciated, receiving an identical average rating of 4.29, reflecting a friendly and engaging atmosphere that promoted active involvement.

The overall experience of the event received a solid 3.86 average rating. A majority (52.4%) gave it 4 stars, while 19% rated it 5, indicating general satisfaction. A small number (4.8%) rated it lower, pointing out scope for minor improvements. Overall, the feedback reflects a well-organized, enjoyable event that offered a mix of challenge and fun. The responses show that CUCA succeeded in making the event both informative and interactive, laying a strong foundation for future student engagement activities.

4. Impact Analysis of the Event

Programme Overview:

Prarambh 2025 was the official business fest organized by the Christ University Commerce Association (CUCA) for first-year commerce students. Spanning from 28th June to 9th July, the event aimed to provide a platform for experiential learning and skill development. It featured domain-specific competitions across Marketing, Finance, HR, Public Relations, Business Quiz, and Best Manager. Each event simulated real-world business challenges, encouraging participants to think critically and act strategically. The fest integrated industry-relevant case studies, crisis management scenarios, and ethical dilemmas. Prarambh promoted teamwork, leadership, innovation, and cross-functional collaboration. Participants were assessed on communication, adaptability, problem-solving, and decision-making. The event successfully bridged academic knowledge with practical application in a dynamic environment.
