Description	The two-day SWO Volunteers Orientation introduced volunteers to the organisation's values, responsibilities, and working processes. It focused on Quality Education through skill-building, leadership, communication, and experiential learning. The orientation promoted Peace, Justice and Strong Institutions by encouraging inclusivity, accountability, teamwork, and ethical conduct. It strengthened Partnerships for the Goals through collaboration among volunteers, coordinators, and the wider student community, while encouraging Responsible Consumption and Production through mindful and efficient use of resources during organisational activities.
Impact	The orientation equipped volunteers with greater confidence, leadership abilities, and a clearer understanding of their roles within SWO. It strengthened teamwork, communication, coordination, and a sense of shared responsibility among volunteers. The two-day programme also fostered inclusivity, discipline, and responsible decision-making while building stronger connections between volunteers and coordinators. Overall, it created a more capable, collaborative, and socially responsible volunteer community prepared to contribute effectively to future SWO initiatives.

Event Description

Following the recruitment and active field work during July's events, the officially inducted SWO Team for the Academic Year 2026-2027 attended an intensive two day orientation program at the CHRIST Yeshwanthpur Campus on July 25th and July 26th. Full residential and dining accommodations were arranged on site for all attending faculty coordinators and student volunteers.

The orientation brought together representatives from all functional wings of the SWO:

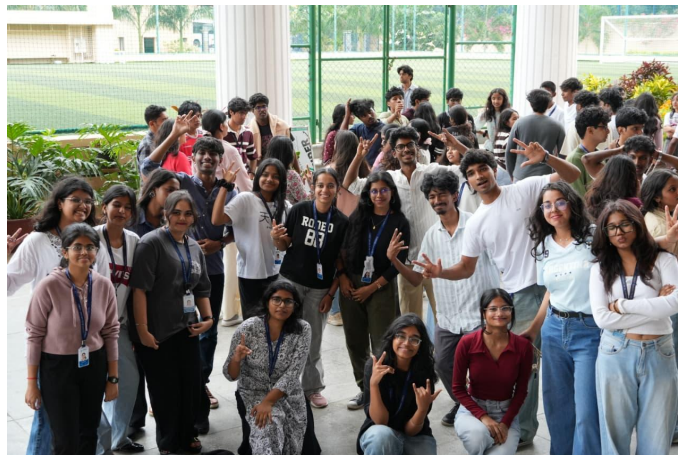
