TUITION FEES:

One Session: 2500 €

ACCOMMODATION FEES:

Cité Internationale Universitaire de Paris (CIUP) - Private rooms in student residence halls. Housing fees are 990 € per session.

CERTIFICATE OF ATTENDANCE

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- An overall aggregate of CGPA 3.5 or higher
- Must be a CHRIST undergraduate student currently enrolled in classes
- Must have completed one year in CHRIST
- Complete the application form and get approval from your department HoD/Coordinator
- Demonstrate your ability to support your stay overseas through a financial plan
- Satisfy host institution and country entry requirements
- Be a good ambassador for the CHRIST (Deemed to be University)
